- RESOLVED: That it is the understanding of the Cambridge City Council that the former Ambassador is being held at Labatan Jirøw Prison, that he is in very poor health and that he has had no opportunity to be tried; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the prompt advice of President Barre as to the health and well-being of Ambassador Azhari and the intentions of the Somalia Government regarding charges against him will be greatly appreciated.

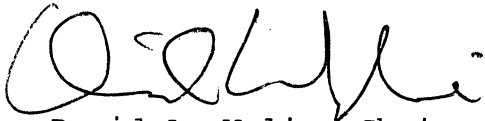
