- WHEREAS:** IOU serves both as a vehicle for self-help and as a means of preventing future involvement with the criminal justice system; and
- WHEREAS:** IOU endeavors to create a presence in the community and engage the public in fulfilling its mission by educating and informing the general public of its activities and services, providing courts and probation departments with ready access to services, assisting local businesses in finding qualified employees, and assisting community groups and churches in addressing problems of crime and employment; and
- WHEREAS:** IOU has been overwhelmingly successful in devising and implementing training programs and employment services for young first offenders under the outstanding leadership of its Executive Director, Edward DePalma; now therefore be it
