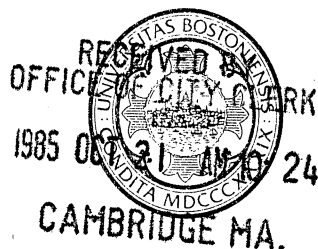

Dear Commissioner,

I regret that I have to write and report a violation of my rights, involving misconduct on the part of Cambridge Police officers.

The incident occurred the evening of October 15 next to the Harvard Square movie theater. I was on the sidewalk distributing fliers about an upcoming theater performance (see enclosed), when the police were called by someone at the theater. This took place around 7:30 p.m.

Despite the fact that I had moved away from the door at the manager's request, despite the fact that I had said if there was any littering I would clean up, despite the fact that I was well within my rights, I was treated very belligerently by the police officers.

- * One officer repeatedly used vulgar language in addressing me.
- * When I asked whether I was doing anything illegal, the response was, "Well, I think there might be a city ordinance."
- * When I tried to continue discussing the matter in a calm manner, I was yelled at and threatened with arrest.
- * The officers wore no identifying name or number, and would not tell me their names or badge numbers when I asked.

I am sure you will understand my outrage as a citizen whose rights were violated. I was not allowed to carry out a perfectly legal activity, and I was treated with a belligerence and hostility totally inappropriate to the situation.

The officers were in car number 234, license plate 444.

I would appreciate a response so that I can feel satisfied that this matter is being given some attention.
