Thank you for your letter dated June 4, 1990 in regard to drainage system in the Alewife Brook watershed. The MDPW agrees with the Belmont Conservation Commission's request that a hydrologic study should be conducted for this area. As you know, such a request was made to the MDC on March 15, 1985. The MDPW is prepared to fund a comprehensive hydrologic study as part of the proposed mitigation measures for the Route 2/Alewife Brook Parkway project. This study would be completed prior to construction of the project, but will not delay the replacement of the Alewife truss bridge.
