

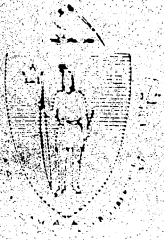

Dear Ms. McDonough:

The Department of Elder Affairs is pleased to announce an award of \$ 8,815. in State Council on Aging formula grant funds for the fiscal year 1 July 1981 through 30 June 1982.

The grantee, through its acceptance of this award, hereby agrees to conduct, operate or maintain this grant in accordance with the original fund application and any conditions or modifications noted below. This grant must be used only to defray the costs of the Council's DART program and extend this service to Boston.

1. All debts and obligations under this program shall be incurred within one year of the date of this letter of award. No grant shall be extended beyond this period without prior written approval of the Department.
2. Grantees shall comply with all State and local laws and regulations regarding non-discrimination in employment, benefits, services and activities.
3. Grantee shall comply with all applicable local advertising and bidding procedures and, in the instance of capital acquisition and/or renovation work, shall seek to include a minority bidder.
4. Any changes in the use of these monies must be requested from the Department in writing; any non-personnel expenditure may vary by up to ten percent (10.0%) from the original cost estimate(s) without giving prior notice to the Department.

5. The Department shall have access at all reasonable times to all books, records and documents of the grantee agency pertaining to this grant for inspection, review and audit.


6. Failure to comply with the grant award and its conditions or modifications shall be cause for termination of the grant and recapture of unallowable costs.

7. The annual report form (DEA-SGA) shall be filed within one month of the end of the current fiscal year, that is, by 31 July 1982.

9. _____ (If an X has been placed here). Grantee shall develop and post a suggested donation or fee schedule for participation in this program/activity. No person shall be denied a service/activity for failure to contribute the suggested donation. All income generated shall be used to further the objectives of this award.

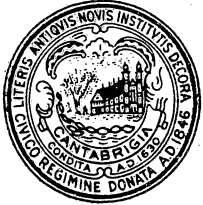
