- WHEREAS: The significant amount of people who remain on this list prohibits new applicants from filing; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Cambridge Housing Authority to provide this City Council with a complete list of all apartments currently vacant in both regular and elderly housing developments, as well as a projected time in which these units will be ready for occupancy; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Housing Authority be requested to submit said report as soon as possible.
