In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-nine.

An Ordinance

in addition to an Ordinance in relation to Sewers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. All surveys, plans and profiles necessary in the construction of sewers, shall be made by the City Engineer, and the Committee on Reservoirs and Drains, whenever in the opinion of the Committee it is expedient; may make contracts for the supply of labor and materials for the construction of any sewer ordered by the City Council; in which case said Committee shall superintend the construction of such sewer, and shall keep the account, and make the report, provided for in the eighth section of the Ordinance in relation to Sewers.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances,
inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
