To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$21,000.00 from the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Department's Extraordinary Expenditure Account to the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Service Programs' Salary and Wages Account (\$16,505.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$4,495.00). The Community Development Department appropriated the U.S. Trust Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) repayment on November 24, 1997. The UDAG funds are used to fund projects of public benefit consistent with the needs of the community as a whole. All applications are reviewed by both the Area Four Neighborhood Coalition and the Community Development Department. The Area Four Neighborhood Coalition has requested the Department of Human Services' Community Learning Center provide ESL and computer classes to Area Four residents as well as provide five slots in the Adult Career Pathways Program. The funds will be used to help cover the cost of instructors and supplies.
