I am pleased to advise you that my Board of Directors has unanimously voted to support the concept of placing a new library building in Central Square.

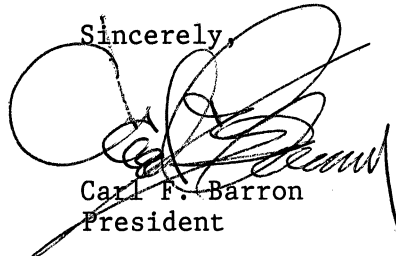

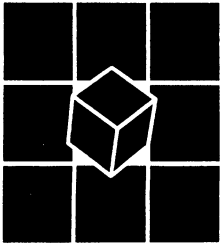

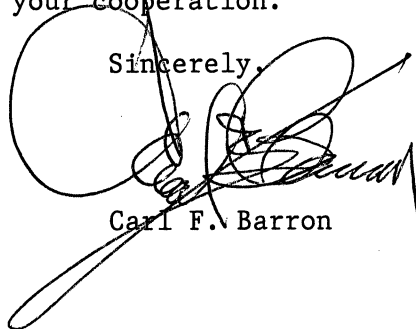
