In Board of Aldermen, October 14th, 1890.

Ordered,

That the Gamewell Fire Alarm Company be authorized to erect and maintain poles, and connect the same with wires, for the purpose of establishing the Police Signal System in this City as authorized by an order of the City Council,- in the locations hereinafter named, Said poles are to be of hard pine or chestnut, not less than thirty feet in <sup>length</sup>~~height~~, five inches square at the top and eight inches square at the level of the sidewalk, ~~and~~ planed and chamfered, and to be set not less than four feet in the ground and well tamped.

The locations of said poles on the several streets are indicated upon three plans thereof furnished by said Company and accompanying this order, and respectively numbered 1, 2, & 3.

LOCATIONS OF POLES.

Mount Auburn Street, south side. (Plan no. 1.)

No. 1. About 80 feet west of Putnam Avenue.

No. 2. About 130 feet west of No. 1.

Kinnaird Street. (Plan no. 2.)

No. 1. On north side about 120 feet east of Western Avenue.

No. 2. On south side about 150 feet east of a point opposite No. 1.

Pleasant Street, north west side. (Plan no. 3.)

No. 1. About 125 feet north-east of Putnam Avenue.

No. 2. About 160 feet north-east of No. 1.

Clark Street, west side. (Plan no. 2.)

One pole about 5 feet south of Harvard Street.

Inman Street, west side. (Plan no. 1.)

One pole about 8 feet south of Broadway.

Spruce Street, south side. (Plan no. 1.)

One pole about 5 feet west of North Avenue.

Brookline Street, west side. (Plan no. 3.)

No. 1. About 146 feet south of Chestnut Street.

No. 2. About 145 feet south of No. 1.

Decatur Street, south side. ( *Plan no 1.* )

- No. 1. Opposite the line of the fence on corner of Brookline Street.
- No. 2. Opposite the line of the fence on the east side of Decatur Court.

Dana Street, east side. ( *Plan no 1.* )

No. 1 About 8 feet north of Harvard Street.

No. 2. About 140 feet north of No. 1.

No. 3. About 238 feet north of No. 2.

No. 4. About 115 feet north of No. 3.

No. 5. About 60 feet north of No. 4.

Putnam Avenue. ( *Plan no 3.* )

No. 1. On south side about 20 feet west of the west line of Brookline Street.

No. 2. On south side about 112 feet west of No. 1.

No. 3. On south side about 140 feet west of No. 2.

No. 4. On south side about 160 feet west of No. 3.

No. 5. On south side about 150 feet west of No. 4.

No. 6. On south side about 135 feet west of No. 5.

No. 7. On south side about 160 feet west of No. 6.

No. 8. On north side about 140 feet west of a point opposite No. 7.

No. 9. On north side about 135 feet west of a point opposite No. 8.

No. 10 On north side about 140 feet west of No. 9.

No. 11. On north side about 100 feet west of No. 10.

No. 12. On north side about 102 feet west of No. 11.
