

City of Cambridge.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.

An Ordinance,  
establishing the salaries of the Chief and Assistant  
Engineers of the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the  
City of Cambridge, as follows:—

1. The pay of the Chief Engineer of the  
Fire Department shall be two hundred dollars  
annually, commencing on the first day of April  
last; and this shall be in full for all services.

2. The pay of the Assistant Engineers of the  
Fire Department shall be fifty dollars, each,  
annually, commencing on the first day of  
April last; and this shall be in full for all  
services.

3. The above salaries shall be paid  
quarterly.

4. All ordinances, or parts of Ordinances,  
inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
