Notice is hereby given that a public meeting will be held by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority in the Auditorium of the Transportation Systems Center of the U. S. Department of Transportation, 55 Broadway, Cambridge, at 8:00 P.M. (EST) on December 18, 1974.

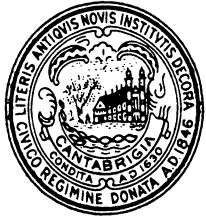
The purposes of the meeting are (1) to provide information on the Environmental Impact Study (EIS) being undertaken by the Authority with respect to the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Project, including a description of the EIS process, proposed EIS work program and schedule, proposed alternative planning models, and citizen participation possibilities, and (2) to solicit comments by the public on the above subjects.

The study is being undertaken pursuant to regulations issued by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Massachusetts Executive Office of Communities and Development under the National Environmental Policy Act and the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act, respectively. The intent of the study is to determine the nature and extent of any adverse environmental impacts expected to be generated by the project and to provide guidance in attempting to minimize the effects of any such adverse environmental impacts through the consideration of alternative development proposals and other means.

Information related to the subject matter of the public meeting will be available for examination prior to the public meeting at the office of the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority, 336 Main Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts and the Office of the City Clerk, Cambridge City Hall.

Any person or organization desiring to be heard in connection with this study may appear and will be given an opportunity to be heard at the public meeting.

The Kendall Square Urban Renewal Project is bounded generally by Third Street on the East, Binney Street on the North, the Boston and Albany (Grand Junction) Branch Railroad on the West, and Main Street on the South.

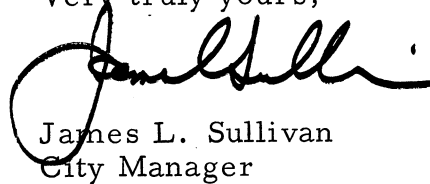
