RESOLVED: That this City Council sends warmest congratulations to the cast and crew of "Laff in the Dark" for their successful performances and their State Championship at the Massachusetts High School Drama Festival and the six All-Star Cast Awards at the New England Drama Festival held in April at Cranston, Rhode Island; be it further
