- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to cease and desist this project until such time as this City Council has had a full hearing to determine the following:
1. The actual date of completion of this project.
 2. The number of City employees that have been involved throughout the duration of this project.
 3. The actual direct and indirect City costs which have been incurred by the City including the salaries of all employees involved, the number of trucks and other City vehicles utilized in this project as well as any other equipment contracted by the City for use in this project.

- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to notify the Water Board, Superintendent of the Water Department, Commissioner of Public Works, Superintendent of the Recreation Department, Conservation Commission, and the Garden Club that the City Council will conduct a public hearing on this matter within one week.
