- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Reverend Mario A. Campi, OFM, a native of Cambridge and former local teacher; and
- WHEREAS: Father Campi entered the Novitiate of the Franciscan Order, Province of the Immaculate Conception in August of 1935, making his first profession of religious vows in August of 1936 and was ordained into the priesthood in June of 1942; and
- WHEREAS: Father Campi held a variety of assignments during his forty-one years in the priesthood, including teaching at the Christopher Columbus High School, Secretary to the Minister Provincial, Secretary of the missions staffed by the Franciscans in Central America and Superior of Saint Anthony's Friary in Wappingers Falls, New York; and
- WHEREAS: Father Campi is remembered by many in Cambridge for his religious fervor and his zeal to help anyone in need of assistance regardless of race, creed or color; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sympathy to the entire Campi family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Campi family on behalf of the entire City Council.
