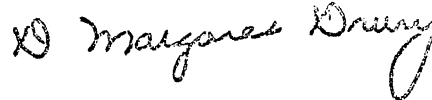

WHEREAS: Robert became assistant corporation counsel for Boston in 1950 and town counsel in Westwood a few years later; and

WHEREAS: Robert later was named first assistant attorney general and was chief investigator for the underground garage case which involved charges of kickbacks, larceny and conspiracy; and

WHEREAS: Robert later became chief counsel of the state Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS: Robert also worked at the Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies, the firm of Peabody, Rivlin, Lambert & Meyers; and

WHEREAS: Robert was named chief counsel of the state Board of Bar Overseers and later became a US magistrate judge in 1979; and

WHEREAS: Robert's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife Jean (Piotti) DeGiacomo; his children Rosamund, Christa, and Jane Buck, Emily Roberts and John DeGiacomo; his brothers Joseph, Richard and John DeGiacomo; his nine grandchildren; and his four great grandchildren; and
