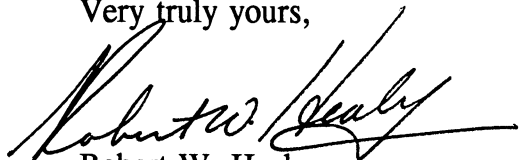

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$100,000.00 to the Public Investment Fund Fire Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account for renovations to the Lafayette Square Fire Station (Engine 2).
