- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant Joseph J. Leary, Jr. has retired from active duty with the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph was first appointed to the Department on March 17, 1968 at which time he was assigned to Engine Five, where he remained until March 5, 1972; when he was transferred to Engine Four where he remained until February 17, 1974; when he was transferred to Ladder Two; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Leary was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on March 13, 1977 at which time he was assigned to the Civil Defense Department, remaining in that assignment until September 10, 1978, when he was transferred to Fire Headquarters; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Leary held this assignment until December 19, 1979 when he was transferred to Engine Four, where he remained until November 16, 1980 when he was transferred to Engine Nine, where he remained until he was reassigned back to Fire Headquarters on May 10, 1981, the assignment from which he retired; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Lieutenant Joseph J. Leary, Jr. upon his retirement and to further extend its wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Leary on behalf of the entire City Council.
