- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that death brought to a close the life of Daniel E. Regan, former life-long Cantabridgian and President of the Somerset Bituminous Board until his retirement, President of the United Paving Company, a Cambridge-based asphalt and cement company; and
- WHEREAS: Daniel was a graduate of Rindge Technical High School and Bentley College, where he majored in finance and upon graduation, served his country during World War I as a member of the United States Army; and
- WHEREAS: Upon receiving his honorable discharge, Daniel played semi-professional football for the Cambridge Legion, as well as the old Fitton Athletic Club of East Boston and he also coached the team during the late 1920's; and
- WHEREAS: Although Daniel was an astute businessman and devoted much of his time to it, he never lost sight of his family responsibility or the needs of others; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the entire Regan family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.

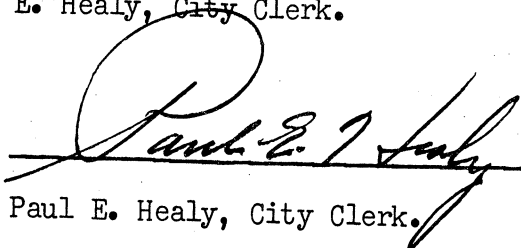
