AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS
THE SENATOR MICHAEL LOPRESTI, SR. RIVERSIDE PARK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

The land between the bank of the Charles river and the Cambridge parkway
from the Broad canal to the Lechmere canal in the city of Cambridge shall be
designated and known as the Senator Michael LoPresti, Sr. Riverside Park, in
memory of state Senator Michael LoPresti, Sr. A suitable marker bearing such
designation shall be erected thereon by the metropolitan district commission.
