Honorable Sirs . We the undersigned Citizens , Tax Payers and Business do hereby protest against any free usage of the property owned by the Citizens and known as the old Brattle Square Police Station . We positively protest beg and pray . THAT you will not grant the request or petition of W Russell Cazmay ex councillor , That this site be given as a free parking space for the Business Men of Harvard Square . We submit the following justifiable reasons . In the first place this land can be sold outright, or leased at an income to the City . FURTHER if you allow free usage , about 90 percent of the parking will be enjoyed by employees and store owners , and skip to Boston Shoppers . WE SEE IN THIS PROJECT A SERIOUS LOSS TO TAXPAYERS AND NOTHING MUCH IN IT TO BUSINESS MEN FROM SHOPPERS . Most business men are quoted as living out of Cambridge due to high TAXATION . There fore we pray that you dismiss this petition , and give leave to withdraw. We ask that a public hearing be granted before committal

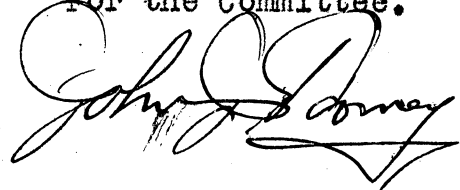
