To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby submitting a loan order to provide funding for \$6,161,000.00 for the following projects included in the FY96 capital budget which the City Council recently received:

Water Main Replacement (\$2,000,000) - This allocation will provide funds for the replacement of approximately four miles of pipe in the water distribution system. Of the approximately 180 miles of pipe in the system, it is estimated that 103 miles will need replacement over the next thirty years.

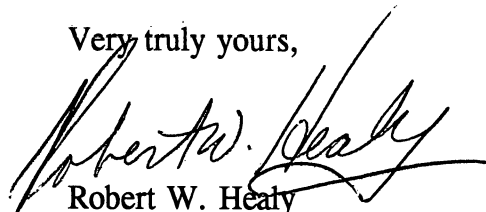
Design Funds for Water Treatment Plant (\$3,600,000) - These funds will supplement \$1,130,000 in previously authorized amounts to provide a total budget of \$4,730,000 for design and engineering costs related to the new water treatment plant. It is anticipated that this loan order will provide all of the funds needed to complete this phase of the project.

Public Building Renovations (\$500,000) - This allocation provides funds for the first phase of improvements to the War Memorial including renovations to the pool and the exterior of the building, (\$250,000); improvements to City Hall Annex concentrating on the restoration of the brownstone facade of the building which has severely deteriorated in recent years and the replacement of the roof membrane and flashing on the Coffon Building (\$180,000); improvements to the heating systems in several fire stations (\$70,000).

One Percent for the Arts (\$61,000) - In accordance with the One Percent for the Arts ordinance, 1% of the three projects shown above will be allocated for the public art program.

For further details on the above-mentioned projects, please see pages V-26 (Water Main Replacement and Design Costs for Treatment Plant), V-46 (War Memorial), V-20 City Hall Annex and Coffon Building), and V-17 (Fire Station Renovations). The One Percent for the Arts allocation shown on page V-39 covers administrative costs associated with the program and is funded through current revenues. The \$61,000 shown in the above paragraph will be set aside for public art.
