- WHEREAS: John not only was an active member of Saint Mary's Parish, but was extremely involved in such worthwhile organizations as the Cambridge Community Schools, serving as a member of the Board of Commissioners from 1970 to 1981 providing many recreational programs for children and adolescents, as well as to the elderly throughout the community, as well as serving as a member and Chairman of the Cambridge Council on Aging, Committee of Elders, Cambridge Multicultural Arts Center, Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee and the Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association; and
- WHEREAS: John will be greatly missed for his persistence and devotion to getting what was "due" for any board or committee he served, because he truly took each assignment with unequivocal zeal and sincerity; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Rita Sousa and the entire Sousa family at the loss of their husband and father; and be it further
