- WHEREAS:** A number of residents in the neighborhoods most effected by the impending Bennett Street Yard development have voiced concern over the project, and
- WHEREAS:** Their primary concern is a lack of coordination between the inter-related projects such as the Kennedy School of Government, the temporary MBTA station and the MDC park, and
- WHEREAS:** A coordinated effort would cost little and would greatly benefit the overall result in that a better system of parks, walkways and public spaces would be created, therefore be it
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take the necessary steps so as to insure a coordinated development, and be it further
- ORDERED:** That he be requested to report back to the Council on the action he has taken pursuant to this request.
