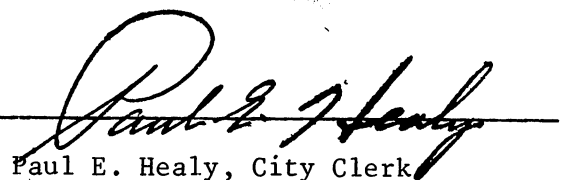

- WHEREAS: Maura was an extremely talented woman and was an active member in the Belmont Dramatic Club, Concord Community Theater and the Wellesley Players; now therefore be it
