- WHEREAS: This emergency situation required an immediate and responsible reaction in order to prevent any personal harm or injury, while trying to maintain the educational programs of the day; and
- WHEREAS: Miss Mary Mroz, Principal of the Robert F. Kennedy Elementary School must be credited for the successful execution of this emergency evacuation, and whose dedication to the schoolchildren of Cambridge should not go unnoticed by this legislative body; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating the faculty and staff of the Robert F. Kennedy Elementary School for a job "well done"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Miss Mary Mroz on behalf of the entire City Council.
