- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Director of Traffic and Parking, License Commission and the Public Works Commissioner to make the appropriate arrangements to allow John F. Kennedy Street to be closed from the corner of Mt. Auburn Street and on part of Brattle Street up to Church Street including part of Palmer Street on Sunday, October 9, 1988 from 9:30 A.M. to 7:30 P.M. in order for the Harvard Square Business Association to participate in the "Oktoberfest", (raindate of Monday, October 10, 1988); and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Chief of Police be and hereby is authorized to issue a permit for the sale of food, beverages and merchandise so that the Business Association can comply with the Massachusetts law on the required date; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the License Commission to take the appropriate steps to have a decibel reading of the Oktoberfest; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to issue a sidewalk sale permit; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Health Department be and hereby is requested to issue a permit for the sale of food and beverages outdoors.

On behalf of the Harvard Square Business Association, I would respectfully request that the City Council grant permission for our organization to hold its tenth annual Oktoberfest in Harvard Square on Sunday, October 9, 1988, with provision for a raindate the following day/Columbus Day, Monday, October 10.

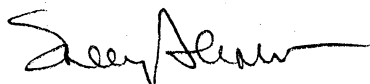
Permission to hold the Oktoberfest would entail granting the following conditions, per usual:

- 1) Permission to hold a non-alcoholic Sunday street fair on one block of John F. Kennedy Street (from the corner of Mount Auburn street) and on the part of Brattle street (up to Church street, including part of Palmer street) on October 9 (or 10/10) from noon until 6 p.m.;
- 2) Overnight posting in order to close part of JFK and Brattle streets to traffic on October 9 (or 10/10) from 9:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. to allow for set-up and for clean-up;
- 3) Placing kiddie rides in and around Brattle Square and a temporary bandstand for traditional entertainment at the intersection of Brattle and JFK street, with allowances for a 12-foot fire lane for emergency vehicles.

The Harvard Square Business Association would again be responsible for providing supervision, public facilities, clean-up, and security for the Harvard Square Oktoberfest.

Please thank the Council and the City Manager for their prompt consideration of our request to hold the 10th annual Oktoberfest in Harvard Square proper.
