Subject Council Order #9 of May 4, 1987 "Pemberton St. Parking"

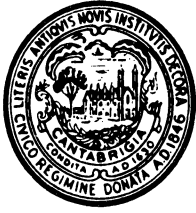
During January, 1979, Permit Parking signs were posted along the south side of Pemberton Street between Sherman Street and the bend. At this time, the frontage of Portland Stoneware was left unrestricted. On Oct. 22, 1985, this was changed and the whole south side was restricted to permit parking only. The north side of Pemberton Street has been posted for No Parking Towaway zone between Middlesex Street and Sherman Street since before 1979.

In checking the signing, two "No Parking Tow" signs were found missing and will be reinstalled shortly. All other signing was found correctly installed. A parking control officer is assigned to this area and vehicles found in violation are being ticketed.

We are in the process of changing the regulations along the south side of Pemberton Street from Sherman Street to Sargent Street. The "No parking Tow Away zone" will become effective on June 12, 1987.
