In Board of Aldermen, *April 15, 1874.*

Ordered, THAT the Superintendent of Streets be, and is hereby Ordered to complete the sidewalk on

Pearl Street
between Main and Chestnut Streets,
by the setting of edgestones on the easterly side
on the westerly side.
And by the setting of edgestones, and paving the same with brick or stone, as may be required, and make such changes in the grade of said street as he shall deem necessary, and remove all such obstructions on the line of said street as he shall deem dangerous, after giving due notice to that effect.

The expense of the same to be charged to the Appropriation for Streets and Paving, and assessed according to law.
