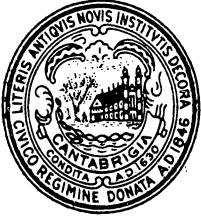

Re: Removal of Bricks

In regard to the following streets, Cogswell Avenue and Hampshire Street, I would like to submit the following information:

1. Hampshire Street - Wellington-Harrington Area Contract, Cambridge Redevelopment Authority. Bricks that are removed by the contractor are part of his contract. This has been previously reported by the CRA and PWD following early questions this year.
2. Cogswell Avenue - Community Development Department, Block Grant Area Project. The Public Works Department has received all used brick, in its Hampshire Street yard, as requested by the Superintendent of Streets. He estimates receipt of 40-50 thousand brick which are being reused for other sidewalk repairs throughout the City. In addition, on Cogswell Avenue approximately 150 feet of granite curb, resalvaged from Kendall Square, has been used to fill gaps on this street.
