WHEREAS: Councillor Walter J. Sullivan introduced a resolution to the Cambridge City Council on August 7, 1989 to investigate the possibility of developing a relationship with a City in Africa for the purpose of cultural and educational exchanges and for international understanding; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council supported the resolution endorsing in principle the establishment of a Sister City relationship with an appropriate city in Sub Sahara, Africa; and

WHEREAS: Mayor Alice Wolf in March, 1991 appointed committee members to the Cambridge-Africa Sister Cities Project Committee; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge School Committee voted to support and endorse the work of the Committee; and

WHEREAS: Mayor Kenneth Reeves has energized the committee and has demonstrated unfailing support of a relationship with a Sub Sahara City; and

WHEREAS: The Committee after a year of serious and studious examination of several cities including the collection of data and information and correspondence with these cities; and

WHEREAS: At a regularly scheduled meeting held on September 30, 1992 the Cambridge-Africa Sister City Committee by acclamation chose the city of Bulawayo, Zimbabwe as an appropriate city for affiliation with the City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor of Bulawayo in a letter to Mayor Reeves, and the Committee has expressed a positive twinning of our cities; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council accept the recommendation of the Cambridge-Africa Sister City Committee and endorse and support the affiliation of Bulawayo, Zimbabwe with the City of Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council profoundly thank the following Committee Members: Lester Lee, Founder; Henrietta Davis, Cambridge School Committee; Joan Qualls Harris and Frances H. Cooper dedicated Co-Chairs of the Committee; Joseph G. Sakey, Committee Clerk and Director of the Cambridge Public Library; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be requested to send copies of the resolution to the members of the Cambridge-Africa Sister City Committee.
