- WHEREAS: Truck traffic on Cameron Avenue has become both an excessive burden and an excessive hazard to the health and safety of the residents thereon as well as neighboring environs; and
- WHEREAS: On Massachusetts Avenue, running South from Alewife Brook Parkway, traffic signs are placed which indicate that trucks are prohibited from Cameron Avenue; and
- WHEREAS: No similar sign indicates the same prohibition as one proceeds along Massachusetts Avenue, North from Porter Square; and
- WHEREAS: This absence of such a sign is a major cause for the presence of the trucking problem on Cameron Avenue; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager mandate the Director of Traffic & Parking to arrange for the immediate placement of a sign on Massachusetts Avenue, at a location North of Porter Square, in such a way that truck operators will be made aware that Cameron Avenue is off-limits; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Chief of Police to insure that, upon completion of the placement of said sign(s), police personnel will be assigned to insure adherence to the stated prohibition.
