In Board of Aldermen, May 10th 1871

Whereas: By an Order passed and approved December 14th 1870. certain parcels of land were taken for public use on Brattle Street and by an omission in said Order no damages were awarded to Davis, Taylor & Demmon for land so taken.

Ordered: That the sum of one hundred eight dollars and twentyfive cents be and the same hereby is awarded to Davis, Taylor & Demmon for land &c so taken.
