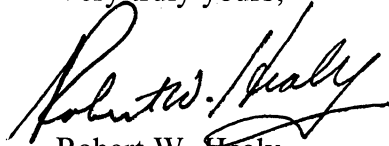
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 99-27, regarding a report on the feasibility of restoring the Board of Aldermen Chamber, Public Works Commissioner Ralph Dunphy reports the following:

Re-establishment of the Aldermen Chamber in the West Wing of City Hall would require the removal of 2,500 square feet of floor space on the third floor. To remove this space and re-establish and renovate the Chamber is conservatively estimated at \$1,000,000.

The renovation would also require the relocation of the departments that currently occupy 5,000 square feet (on the 2nd and 3rd floors.) There is no available City space at this time to relocate affected departments (Personnel, Revaluation, and the Credit Union.) In addition, the renovation would result in the removal of two restrooms. The removal of these restrooms would reduce the number of available toilet fixtures to below the current level required by building code.
