but you did not go alone.

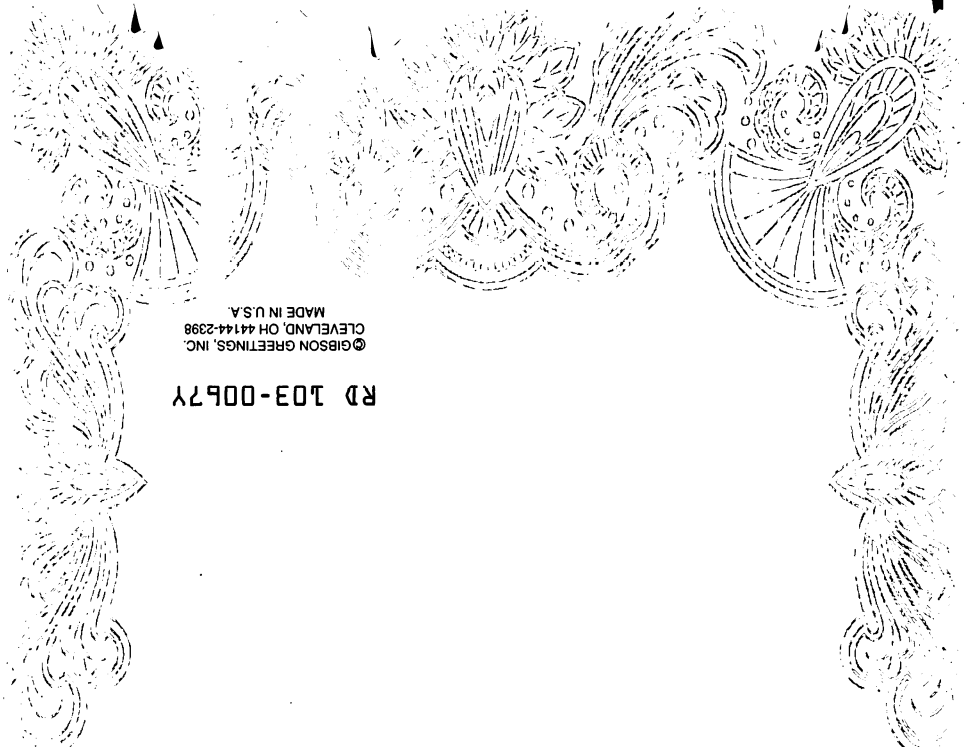
A part of us went with you,
