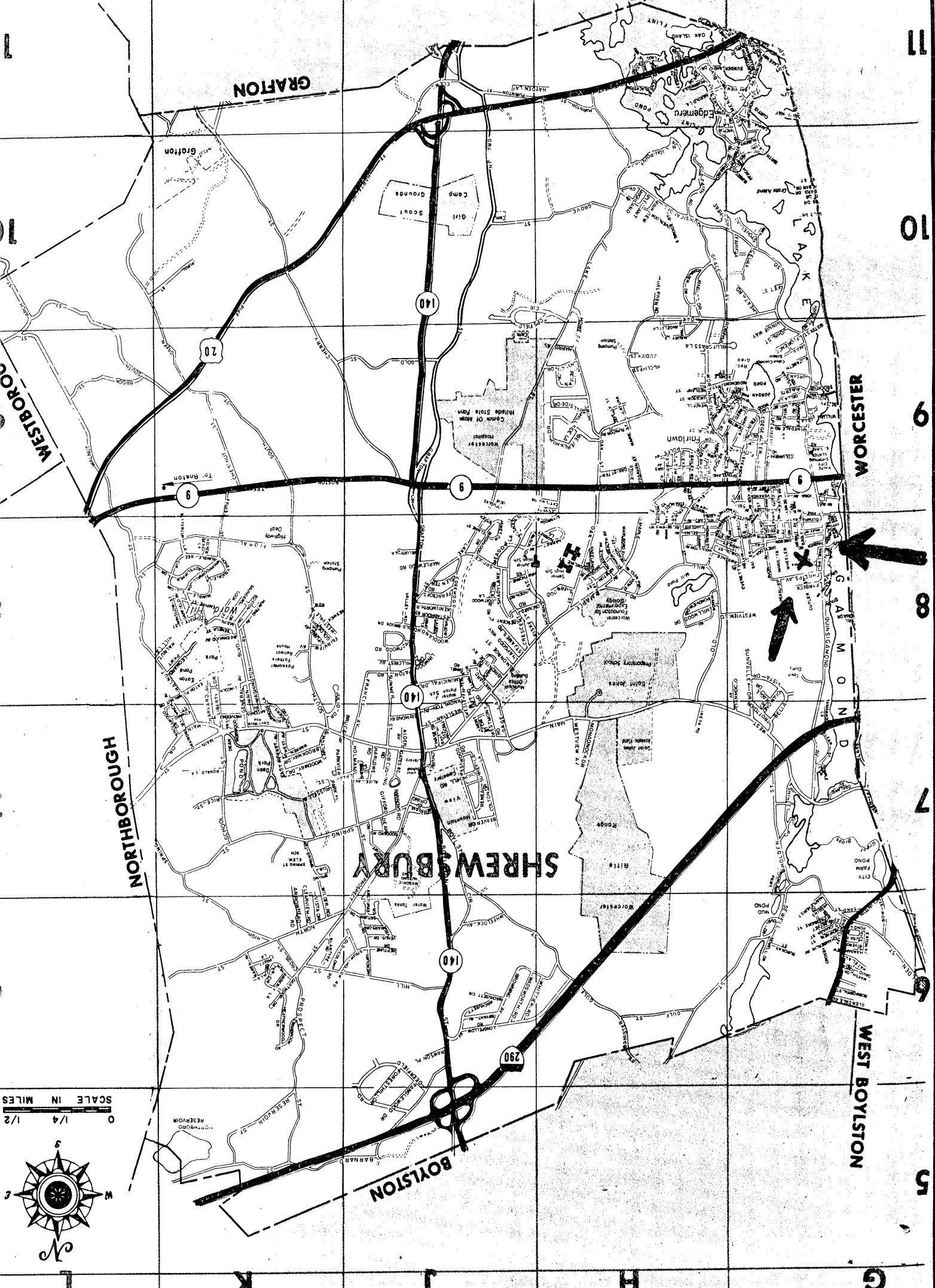
From Worcester Rte. 9

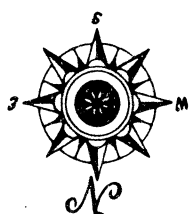
