Yours of the 27th. ult. was sent to Keene but reached us all right but some late. Since that I have seen Mr Henderson Chairman of the Committee on Roads & Bridges and both he and Mr. McSorley said they did not want any edgestone yet. Mr McSorley and I also looked over the cars of stone in the freight yard and he show me the objectionable pieces and also those that were right and I shall endeavor to send such stone as are satisfactory to your Committee. I have this day received orders from the Supt. of Streets to commence delivering stone next Tuesday and I have directed our teamster to begin at that time. The four circle stone for the lamp post in Central Sq. will be delivered first and then the edgestone for Main St. Hoping that everything will be satisfactory
