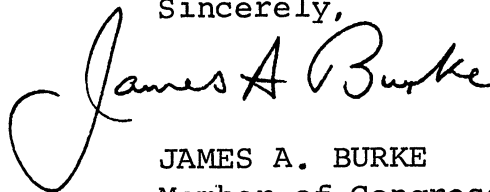
Dear Mr. Healy:

I want to thank you for forwarding me a copy of Cambridge City Council's order which urges the support of S. 679 and of H.R. 3354, bills to open up the highway trust fund for the use of funds in mass transit.

As you know, S. 679 was entered as an amendment to the Senate Highway Bill, S. 502, and was passed. The House Public Works Committee has held hearings on H.R. 3354 and will in fact be going into a mark-up session on the House Highway Bill tomorrow. It is expected that the House bill will be reported to the Whole House in the very near future. You may be sure that the Council's order will have my careful and sympathetic attention at that time.
