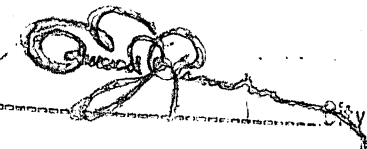
December 9, 1919.

Estates benefitted to be assessed according to law.

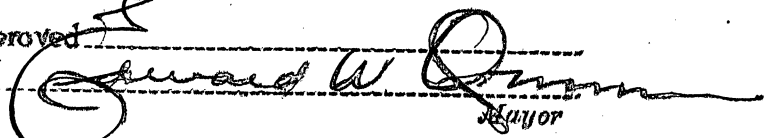
