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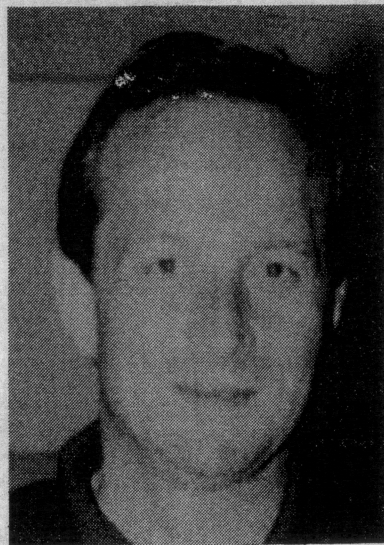
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FRANK W. RONCHETTI JR.

Frank Ronchetti Jr., 43

Executive in security industry

Frank W. Ronchetti Jr. of Lynnfield, regional vice president for ADI of Boston, died Thursday in St. Elizabeth Hospital in Brighton. He was 43.

Mr. Ronchetti was born in Cambridge. He was a graduate of North Cambridge Catholic High School and Newbury Junior College in Boston. He served in the US Army during the Vietnam War.

At the time of his death, he was serving as the regional vice president for ADI in Boston, a supplier to the security industry. He had been associated with ADI since 1988. He began his career in the security industry as a technician.

Mr. Ronchetti had been a resident of Lynnfield for the past 14 years, and he was a member of Our Lady of the Assumption Church.

Mr. Ronchetti leaves his wife, Diane F. (Poirier); a son, Craig F. of Lynnfield; his parents, Frank W. and Joanna (Gulino) of Cambridge and a sister, Roseann of Medford.

A funeral Mass will be said tomorrow at 10 a.m. in Our Lady of the Assumption Church in Lynnfield. Burial will follow in Puritan Lawn Memorial Park in Peabody.
