In Board of Aldermen, May 18th 1887

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads & Bridges be authorized to advertise for proposals for building a Bulwark on the south side of Mount Auburn Street, west of the "Casino grounds", the same to be in accordance with plans drawn by the City Engineer.

Also, to cause such bulwark to be built either by contract, or by the day under the direction of the City Engineer, at the option of said Committee.

The expense thereof not to exceed the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, the same to be charged to the appropriation for that Department (Repairs.)
