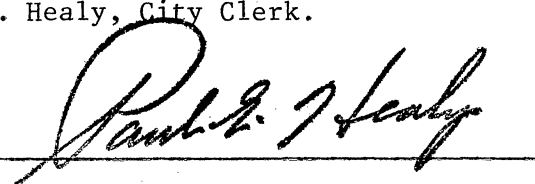

- WHEREAS: The outside construction at Porter Square is still to be completed; and
- WHEREAS: Reconstruction of the bridge at Porter Square will commence soon, taking a period of two years; and
- WHEREAS: Pedestrians crossing to the station from either side of the bridge are hazardous; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager review carefully with the Chief of Police and the Director of Traffic these pedestrian crossings with a goal of implementing a plan for pedestrian safety, especially during the bridge construction period; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager ensure that the MBTA properly complete its share of the work for safe pedestrian crossing.
