WHEREAS:

The Pushcarts have long been a source of pride, joy and value to the Metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS:

The City of Cambridge, unlike the City of Boston, would love to have the Pushcarts come over here to operate in our squares and public places; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Mayor of Cambridge and the Cambridge City Council hereby extends a formal invitation to the Pushcarts of Boston to come over the bridge and find a new home here in Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That a meeting be established as soon as possible between a representative of the Pushcart operation and the Mayor of the City of Cambridge.
