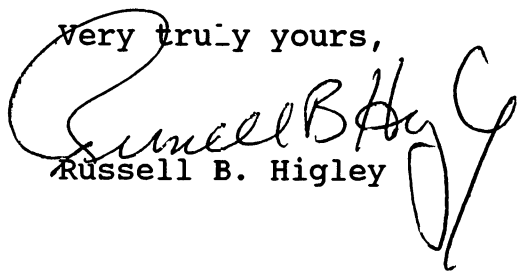

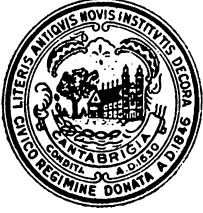

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance entitled "The Municipal Code of the City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2.58 of the Code (Officers and Employees Generally) is hereby amended by striking out §2.58.010 thereof and substituting the following new §2.58.010:

2.58.010 Residency requirement - Exception

A. Every person, who, on or after the effective date of this section (, 1993), is first employed by the City of Cambridge, shall become a domiciled resident of the City within one year from the date of such employment, and shall remain a domiciled resident thereof during the term of such employment.

B. This section shall not apply to City employees who are specifically allowed by statute to reside outside City limits.

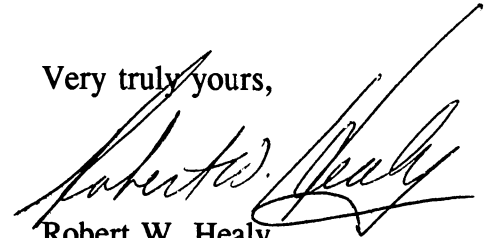
