

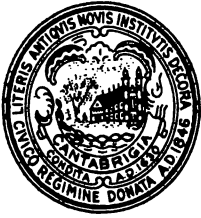
To provide funds for snow removal contracts and non-block grant street and sidewalk maintenance.


