WHEREAS:-

Frank J. Lehan, a former member of the City Council, has passed away and his death has caused sorrow to many of his ~~former~~ associates and friends, it is deemed fitting and proper that some notice of this sad event should be recorded.

Mr. Lehan was of an old and respected family of East Cambridge and it was but natural that he should develop a flair for politics and public life. This he did at an early age and represented old Ward One in the Common Council for several years serving as its president during the year 1914. In 1915, under the new charter, he was elected as a Councillor from Ward One and served for a period of ten years. While in public office he studied law, was admitted to the Bar and practised until the time of his death.

There have been few men elected to office who acquired a better knowledge of the public business than Frank J. Lehan. Elected year after year to serve the citizens of Cambridge he became expert in parliamentary procedure, in legislative affairs and municipal finance and was responsible for much constructive legislation. He labored arduously for the enactment of the Zoning Law and had the satisfaction of seeing it in operation before retiring from public life. He was ever loyal to his friends; he was able to smile however fortune turned; he possessed a peculiar talent of producing effect in whatever he said and did - such a man was Frank J. Lehan.
