SUBJECT: Committee on Finance Motions Relative to FY89-90 Budget

The following represents a compilation of all motions and requests made by members of the City Council during the public hearings regarding the budget for the next fiscal year.

PUBLIC SAFETY FUNCTION

Councillor Walsh: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consider the application of "User" fees for the educational institutions when the services of the Police or Fire Department are required.

TRAFFIC & PARKING

Councillor Walsh: Director of Traffic and Parking consider the feasibility of installing meters around the property owned by Harvard University, with particular attention to Oxford Street.

Councillor Duehay: The City Manager consider recommending an ordinance establishing fines for the abuse of visitor passes.

POLICE REVIEW & ADVISORY BOARD

Councillor Walsh: That the Police Review Board be placed under the jurisdiction of the Assistant City Manager for Human Services.

INSPECTIONAL SERVICES

Councillor Walsh: City Manager consider providing the necessary personnel to the Commissioner of Inspectional Services to provide for a City-wide inspection of multi-family homes.

Councillor Russell: City Manager consider providing an ordinance amendment to the Council establishing fines for repeat offenders of Health and Sanitary Code violations.

WATER/INSPECTIONAL SERVICES/RENT CONTROL

Councillor Duehay: City Manager the feasibility of greater utilization of inter-departmental personnel relative to inspections required to be made between the Inspectional Services Department and the Rent Control Board.

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICE PROGRAMS

Councillor Graham: City Manager provide an additional \$4,000.00 to the Youth Enrichment Program operated by Harvard University.

RENT CONTROL

Councillor Walsh: City Manager consider appointing an efficiency expert for the Rent Control Office to determine whether or not they have sufficient personnel, and, if so, is the personnel functioning to its optimum capability.

EXECUTIVE

Vice-Mayor Wolf: City Manager report to the City Council after the adoption of the FY-90 Budget the funding mechanism programs and hiring policies of Employment Resources Incorporated; said report to include whether or not the program complies with the City ordinance relative to the employment plan.

CITY CLERK

Councillor Walter Sullivan: That the City Clerk's budget and memorandum requesting a supplemental appropriation be referred to the City Manager for a report prior to adoption of the municipal budget.

SCHOOL DEPARTMENT

Councillor Duehay:

That the Committee on Finance forwards to the full City Council the School Department appropriation for FY90 in the amount of \$65,189,425. as submitted by the City Manager with the understanding that a recommendation will be made by the City Manager concerning the supplemental request of \$1,569,957. prior to the meeting of May 15, 1989.
