Mildred Albert was known to many as Boston's "Modeling," after her first modeling job for the professional modeling agency in 1935.

In 1935, Mrs. Albert published the Academy of Modeling. During the school history, more than 100 students walked through the academy's New York doors.

Mrs. Albert also published the Hart Modeling Agency in 1944, a prominent modeling agency in New York.

"It was a joy to have said Smoki Bacco as host and event planner at the ton."

"It's extraordinary that she was in such a field. She was the son I knew," she said.

In April, May L. Flynn declared Mrs. Albert the city's "grande dame" at the Corbin suite in the hotel named in her name.

"Like a grand dame, she embodied certain conduct and self-discipline. She was a never-tiring mover and shaker in the arts and motion picture industry right up to the end," said Boston Society Editor Dana.

Renowned for her work in the world of haute couture, she interviewed such as Christian Dior, Cardin, Halston and Blass.
