I am in receipt of your letter dated October 16, 1985.  
I apologize for the delay but I was unaware a response was  
still outstanding.

The officers involved in the incident you described were  
required to submit reports and the entire matter was investiga-  
ted by the Night Patrol Captain.

The officers were at the theatre at the request of the  
manager. In his report, one of the officers states he did  
give you his name after you requested it. Although one of the  
officer admits using vulgar language, based on the circumstances,  
I believe the officers acted properly.

The officer using the vulgar language was advised of the  
policy of the Cambridge Police Department to be courteous at all  
times to the community we deal with.

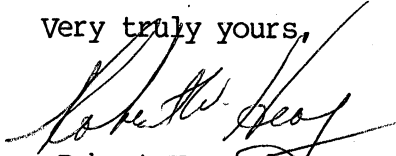

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find a response from Chief Anthony Paolillo to Awaiting Report Item No. 26 regarding an October 15, 1985 incident next to Harvard Square Theatre involving the distribution of leaflets. As Chief Paolillo points out, the allegations by Mr. Peter Wulkan were investigated by the Night Patrol Captain and I have reviewed his report as well as those of the two officers involved.

These reports reveal that Mr. Wulkan was indeed violating a city ordinance by blocking the entrance to the theater while distributing his leaflets. The police investigation concludes that the one officer who was asked did provide his name and badge number at Mr. Wulkan's request, and the officer who used vulgar language during the incident has been admonished.
