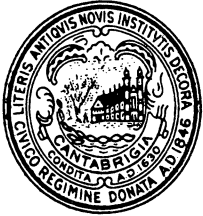

Subject: Sidewalk Construction

The City Council this year, as in previous years, has passed a number of requests for sidewalk improvements. Years ago before the influx of state and federal aid, sidewalks were financed with the city paying half and the property owner pay half. However, for the past two years and continuing this year, there have been no funds in the department budget for the city's share of the sidewalk construction under the Betterment Program. We have been installing sidewalks exclusively under the various grant and aid programs.

I request that you ask the City Council to notify all people prior to filing applications for new construction, that if they expect the work to be done they will have to bear the entire cost, as this department has no funds available; and it does not appear that there will be any relief in the near future.
